





- Review of presentations prior to ASM (SAC & CAG)
- Opportunity for membership to comment and for trial design to be modified

Scientific review

- Formal review of protocol
- Recommendations to Endorse, Develop, or Reject (SAC and CAG)
- May be re-submitted if appropriate



• Final decision (Executive Committee)

 Develop a non-exhaustive ranked list of musculoskeletal research questions that will enable ANZMUSC to determine if projects meets endorsement criterion 1 (ANZMUSC research priority)
