ANZMUSC has received 23 applications for the 4 seeding grants valued at \$10,000 each. Details of the grant recipients and projects are given below:

1. **Associate Prof Christine Lin** (*School of Public Health, The University of Sydney*) for the study - "Understanding barriers and facilitators to opioid deprescribing in primary care for the development of patient deprescribing resources".
2. **Prof Cathie Sherrington** (*School of Public Health, The University of Sydney*) for the study - "Safe mobility to prevent falls in acute hospitals: adaptation of the successful Safe Recovery rehabilitation unit".
3. **Associate Prof Mark Hancock** (*Department of Health Professions, Macquarie University*) for the study – "Feasibility of testing the effectiveness of a theory-informed implementation intervention to reduce imaging for low back pain: a pilot cluster randomised controlled trial"
4. **Dr Milena Simic** (*Faculty of Health Sciences, The University of Sydney*) for the study – "Reducing non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drug use in people with knee osteoarthritis: A repeated measures study for risk minimization"
